As you are likely aware, public opposition to the establishment of the first industrial octopus farm is steadily increasing as consumers are becoming more informed about the potential environmental, economic, public health, and animal welfare implications of this initiative. Once again, the Aquatic Animal Alliance, a coalition of 117 organizations worldwide dedicated to improving aquatic animal well-being, urges Cooke to reconsider its decision to acquire Nueva Pescanova and engage in the octopus farming endeavor. We hold deep concerns about the potential impacts of this project on marine ecosystems, animal welfare, and Cooke's reputation as an environmentally conscious company.

To date, <u>Nearly one million people have already voiced</u> their disapproval of this project through an online petition led by the social mobilization network Avaaz. Despite public resistance and numerous warnings from the scientific community, Nueva Pescanova continues to disregard the risks posed by the facility to the health of the local community, the environment, and the animals themselves.

A new <u>study</u> commissioned by Avaaz and conducted by the Aquatic Life Institute, an international non-profit organization dedicated to improving the welfare conditions of aquatic animals in the food system, reiterates the seriousness of the risks associated with the initiative. The report highlights that octopuses are susceptible to bacterial skin infections, with the potential for transmission to humans. Furthermore, serious environmental and economic problems can occur without appropriate management of the large amount of waste generated by processing industries.

The Aquatic Life Institute has uncovered a significant publication that has not been previously discussed. The 234-page "Handbook of Pathogens and Diseases in Cephalopods," created in partnership with the European Commission, illustrates the presence of bacterial infections in Octopus vulgaris (the species of octopus that would be farmed) that can infect humans and cause severe gastroenteritis, septicemia, and even death.

Scientists have consistently highlighted their concerns regarding octopus farming since the inception of this project. These concerns revolve around the fact that octopuses, like many other species exploited within the food system, are not suited in any way, shape, or form for large-scale farming. Nueva Pescanova has completely failed to recognize the variety of diseases that have already been observed for O. vulgaris, and they have failed to incorporate



any farm management practices to prevent the next public health crisis for Las Palmas communities. They have even boldly claimed to the Canary Islands environmental agency that they will not use antibiotics on the farm. There are also grave concerns on putting further pressure on overfished wild populations in order to provide adequate nutrition for the octopus as it is a carnivorous species.

As a leading figure in the industry, Cooke holds the potential to drive positive change in the aquaculture sector. Rather than pursuing the acquisition of Nueva Pescanova and endorsing the establishment of octopus farms, we encourage you to prioritize sustainable practices that champion marine life's well-being, environmental conservation, and responsible aquaculture advancement.

By promoting responsible and more ethical practices, your company can set a new standard for the entire industry and inspire others to follow suit. We would welcome the opportunity to engage in constructive discussions with you and your team to explore more ethical and environmentally-friendly alternatives.
